Reference After Action Report dated 13 June 2005.

The Royal School of Artillery has completed creating the training curriculum for the antique artillery school for the USFAA. The recommendations and edits provided by Arthur Street and Kieran McMullen of the USFAA have been incorporated into the training manuals, and a separate edition of the training manuals created for the USFAA. I developed a license agreement for the USFAA that allows them to copy their manuals and provide them to their students, but they cannot change the content nor provide the manuals to any other artillery school organization. We own all copyrights to the content. ISBN Numbers have been obtained for the RSA and USFAA versions of the manuals listing the RSA as the publisher. Copies of all of the manuals are being provided to the US Library of Congress to register and secure our copyrights.

PURPOSE:

Participating in educational activities is a core function of the 1st Regiment Royal Artillery and the Royal School of Artillery. By providing educational materials that can be used by a branch of the United States Army, we build closer ties with this military organization and advance our goals of the recognition of the RHRA and the HRPP.

RESULTS:
